

Canada Pavilion at AIDS 2018 *featuring* Canadian HIV/AIDS research and programming

This year, the 22nd International AIDS Conference (AIDS 2018), hosted in Amsterdam, Netherlands from July 23 to 27, will highlight the theme “**Breaking Barriers, Building Bridges.**” The theme of the Canada Pavilion will be “**Canada: Building on our Diversity.**”

The Canadian Society for International Health is pleased to be developing and coordinating activities for the Canada Pavilion at AIDS 2018. The Canada Pavilion will showcase research, best practices, achievements, and challenges met and overcome in the Canadian response to HIV/AIDS.

Aside from telling the stories of individuals living with HIV in Canada, **this is an opportunity to showcase innovative and effective projects and programs, especially at the grassroots and community levels, as well as noteworthy research.**

We are looking for submissions in two categories:

1. **Electronic resource**

If you, your organization or your research team have worked in the field of HIV/AIDS in the past two years, either in Canada or abroad, and would like us to feature your project electronically on-site at the Canada Pavilion or in an online resource bank, please submit a file in one of the following formats:

- Research report, including photos
- Video depicting your project
- Virtual photo album
- Newspaper article or other media clip featuring your work
- Other ...

2. **Pavilion activity**

If you plan on attending AIDS 2018 and would like to organize an activity based on your work, as part of the Canada Pavilion programming, we are also accepting proposals for Pavilion activities. Pavilion activities may include a short video and a live commentator, an art exhibit, a participatory activity related to research or programming, etc.

We ask that you include the following in your submission:

- Name, age and province/territory of residence
- Organizational or academic affiliation (if applicable)
- A completed Consent Form (attached)
- High-resolution JPEG photo(s) , if applicable
- Project materials and/ or detailed description of proposed activity
